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HYPERBARIC OXYGEN THERAPY

The Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy (HBO) program at St. Louise follows the guidelines of the elite Undersea and Hyperbaric Medical Society (UHMS). UHMS has the highest standards of care and patient safety to ensure that the utmost quality is maintained within the hyperbaric specialty.

Our wound care specialists design personalized hyperbaric oxygen treatment plans for patients based on diagnosis from their referring physician.

Benefits of HBO Therapy:

- Reduces Healing Time for Injured Tissues
- Reduces Body's Inflammatory Responses
- Stimulates Release of Stem Cells
- Increases White Blood Cell Production
- Neovascularization and Angiogenesis

HBO Therapy Treatment and Conditions:

- Gas gangrene
- Acute traumatic peripheral ischemia
- Crush injuries and suturing of severed limbs
- Progressive necrotizing infections (necrotizing fasciitis)
- Acute peripheral arterial insufficiency
- Preparation and preservation of compromised skin grafts
- Chronic refractory osteomyelitis
- Osteoradionecrosis
- Soft tissue radionecrosis
- Actinomycosis
- Diabetic wounds of the lower extremities meeting criteria
